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GUIDELINES FOR THE SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

- If you would like to be married at St. Joseph's church and you are not a parishioner you will need to complete your marriage preparation, requisite documentation, pre-marital inventory and necessary dispensations with the Pastor of your parish. In order to reserve a wedding date please provide a letter from your Pastor agreeing to the above requirements and giving his permission to be married outside of your parish.
- Call the Administrative Assistant to get information. Office hours are 8:30 am – 1 p.m. Tuesday and Thursday. Phone: 860-526-5495; Email: office@olos-stj.org at least 6 months prior to your requested wedding date.
- Fill out Marriage Information form online (<http://www.stjosephschester.org/marriageform.html>).
- Meet with the priest to complete the Pre-marital investigation (PMI) forms at least 2 to 3 months prior to wedding. Please bring the above documents with you at this time.
- Obtain the required documents. (a) Baptismal certificate issued within six months of wedding date. (b) First Communion and Confirmation certificates.
- Complete a mandatory Marriage Preparation Program: This can be done through the local parish. For St. Joseph's or Our Lady of Sorrows, Contact: Chris Mularski at 860-526-5524. Or a weekend retreat through the Diocese of Norwich. Contact Susan Williams at the Office of Family Life in Norwich, CT. Phone: 860-889-8346 ext.283; Email: familylifeoffice@comcast.net
You will receive a certificate verifying that the program has been completed which must be forwarded to our office. If you live outside the area, you may also attend a program through your local parish or diocese. Please contact your local parish for information.
- The marriage license can be obtained at the Chester Town Hall 3 months prior the wedding date, and must be provided to Fr. Peter at least 1 month before the wedding.
- Make arrangements for music with our organist three months prior to wedding date. Our organist is Mr. Don Grant. He can be reached at 203-430-4292 or music@stjosephs-chester.org.

Organist: Fees for organist and other musicians are determined by and paid directly to them. It is assumed that St. Joseph's organist will be used for the wedding and their fee is payable at time of initial consult. Should alternative musicians/music be used, a fee of \$50.00 is still payable to St. Joseph's organist.

- Schedule of fees:
